Southwest Tech and the Laptop Program Committee are very excited to announce updates to the newly re-named Charger Tech 360. The purpose of the Charger Tech 360 program is to support students with the technology they need to complete their degree at Southwest Tech. The College designed Charger Tech 360 to offer complete technical support, so you don't have to worry about the "techy" stuff and concentrate on learning. We received a lot of feedback about the expanded access to reliable technology from faculty, staff, and students. Southwest Tech has taken feedback and continuously improved access to reliable technology to serve students better.

CHARGER TECH 360

Eligibility requirements tied to program areas remain the same, with the addition of the Liberal Arts University Transfer program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Enrolled in six or more credits
 - *Students taking less than six credits have the option to opt-in beginning December 1, 2020*
- A program that is eligible for Financial Aid
- Not on Academic Denial
- Good Financial Standing

Programs that are not eligible are the following:

- Apprenticeships
- Drive Safety Education Certificates
- Emergency Medical Technician
- EMT
- Laboratory Science Technician
- Nail Technician
- Nursing Assistant (CNA)

The College offers a variety of dual credit options for high schools in Southwest Tech's district. The Start College Now and ColLEDGE Up students are not eligible for the program. All students enrolling in Pathway Certificates are also not eligible for the Charger Tech 360 program.

HOW DOES THE CHARGER TECH 360 PROGRAM WORK?

For the 2020-2021 academic year, all students will receive a rebate for the technology fee. Next year, the 2021-2022 academic year, all eligible students will be charged a technology fee of \$400 each semester. Two-year program students will be able to keep the machine after two years. Short term program students will need to turn the hardware back in. Students in two-year programs will keep the laptop upon graduation after participating for at least four semesters in the Charger Tech 360 program. Students in short term programs (less than two years) will turn the laptop back into ITS upon graduation.
