The parties of this agreement, WTCS and the Lakeland University RN to BSN Completion Program, hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

- Eligibility for Admission: Successful completion of the Associate of Applied Science Nursing at a WTCS college with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above. An active, unencumbered RN license is required prior to enrolling in the nursing core curriculum.
- Transferring as an Associate Degree Graduate: Associate degree nursing graduates from the WTCS are eligible to transfer up to 72 semester hours of credit that will then be applied toward a Lakeland University Bachelor of Science (BSN) degree (see transfer guide below). Individual evaluation of WTCS nursing graduates' transcripts will be reviewed to maximize credit transfer. Additionally, applicants who have college-level work from a four-year college will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis to maximize credit transfer.
- Technical Diploma Credit: Associate degree nursing graduates who began in technical diploma level programs as their pathway to completing their Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing (ADN) will have their credits recognized in the same manner as the Associate of Applied Science Nursing program.
- Curriculum: Applicant agrees to complete the remaining coursework in the RN to BSN Completion Program.

  Maintenance of at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average in the NUR courses, earn a minimum of a C in all NUR courses, and maintain an overall cumulative 2.5 grade point average.
- Graduation Credits: A total of 120 semester hours (credits) (WTCS + LU) are needed to confer the BSN degree at Lakeland University. In addition, a minimum of 30 semester hours of college credit must be earned through Lakeland University.
- Publication of Agreement: Each institution may market this agreement.
- Continuation of Agreement: This agreement will take effect upon the signing of the parties and shall continue until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

# WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM AND LAKELAND UNIVERSITY

## RN to BSN COMPLETION PROGRAM

The purpose of this document is to establish a cooperative relationship between Lakeland University's (LU) Kellett School and the sixteen (16) schools in the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) to provide a Baccalaureate degree opportunity to students that are completing an Associate Degree in Applied Science in Nursing and wishing to enroll in LU's RN to BSN Completion Program. This partnership will assist in better serving the needs of associate degree students with personalized admissions and academic advising services throughout the student's lifecycle.

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of this partnership, the WTCS schools will allow LU to provide students with information about LU's RN to BSN Completion Program through mutually agreed upon channels of communication; and,

THEREFORE, LU recognizes that a partnership with WTCS schools will provide students enrolled in the agreed upon program on a tuition free basis LU's GEN 112: Composition II class.

**FURTHER, LET IT BE RESOLVED**, LU will provide a consortium scholarship to students in the WTCS Nursing program. The scholarship will be equal to a 10% discount for the remainder of the students Baccalaureate studies at LU, guaranteed admission following graduation, start as a junior, free application, and support from LU advisors.

This partnership is effective, August 1, 2019, and will continue until either party requests the dissolution of said partnership in writing and signed by the authorized representative.
