

7 Easy Steps to get your Driver's License



1. Take the Driver Education Theory Class.

(30) hours face-to-face class at your high school or take the class online. Click here to register Call (608) 822-2706 for questions.



2. Take the permit test in your class or at the DMV.

After successfully completing your face-to-face theory class, take the **Permit Test** issued by your instructor. All online students will need to go to their local DMV to take the **Permit Test.** Click here for more info on the DMV permit requirements.

Go to your local DMV to obtain your permit.

5. Drive with your instructor.

6. Schedule road test with the DMV.
